Scheme.

Scheme made by the Minister of Education under the Charitable Trusts Acts, 1853 to 1925.

#### The Foundation

1. In this Scheme the expression "the Foundation" means the Recreation Ground, in the Ecclesiastical Parish of Painswick, in the County of Gloucester, founded by an Indenture dated 12 February 1907 made under the Recreation Grounds Act, 1859, and now regulated by the said Indenture and a Scheme made by the Charity Commissioners on 1 July 1927.

## Administration

2. The Foundation and its endowment (including the particulars specified in the Schedule to this Scheme) shall be administered in conformity with the provisions of this Scheme by the Painswick Parish Council as the trustee thereof.

# Recreation Ground

3. The land belonging to the Foundation shall be held as public ground for the purposes of the Recreation Grounds Act, 1859, for the benefit of the Ecclesiastical Parish of Painswick.

# Application of Income

4. After payment of any expenses of administration, the net income of the Foundation shall be applied by the Painswick Parish Council in the maintenance or improvement of the Recreation Ground.

## Questions under Scheme.

5. Any question as to the construction of this Scheme, or as to the regularity or the validity of any acts done or about to be done under this Scheme, shall be determined conclusively by the Minister of Education upon such application made to him for the purpose as he thinks sufficient.

#### Interpretation

6. The Interpretation Act, 1889, applies to the interpretation of this Scheme as it applies to an Act of Parliament.

### Date of Scheme

7. The date of this Scheme shall be the day on which it is established by an Order of the Minister of Education.
