

General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

In order to comply with GDPR - Members should no longer be using 'your' own email addresses for Council related correspondence/business.

It is possible that an information request could be received from an individual - where that individual is given the **right** to look through your emails.

I would therefore recommend that the Council adopts official '.gov' emails for all correspondence relating to Council business.
