5. MATTERS REQUIRING A DECISION:

- a. S.19/0213/HHOLD CEDAR HOUSE, Stamages Lane
Timber car port (revised plans - alteration to the location of the car port and withdrawal of the garage conversion).

The Committee agreed to Support this application.

- b. S.19/0338/VAR CEDAR HOUSE, Stamages Lane
Variation in condition 3 (domestic use only) from S.10/0656/HHOLD to allow annexe use ancillary to dwelling and holiday-let.

- c. S.19/0394/HHOLD WOODLEA, Slad
Demolition of attached coal and binstore. Construction of new extension and conversion of existing garage to provide an annexe.

Internal alternations, improvements and upgrades. Proposed dormer windows and rooflights.

The Committee agreed to Support this application, but wished to have the application conditioned to ensure that there is an adequate "method statement" to ensure that the Highways is not compromised and that the building waste is correctly removed from the site.

New external swimming pool and pool building.

The Committee agreed to Support this application but wished to point out that the main sewer pipe systems runs through the grounds of Painswick Mill.

G1: 6 conifers- Fell. T1: Ash fell T2: Sycamore remove loose branch T3: Ash- remove secondary limb overhanging reservoir T4: Ash- hole at base, fell. T5: Ash fell. T6: Ash remove limb overhanging reservoir. T7: Sycamore - fell. T8: Ash fell. T9: Ash fell. T10: Ash fell. T11: Beech- reduce overhanging, secondary limb back to 2m stump. T12: Ash-Fell. T13: Beech- reduce overhanging secondary limb back to trunk.
