Cllr Smith has met with the Road Safety Officer and has been offered a choice of:

A mobile VAS – that must be moved regularly with at least 4 different sites.

Or APNR camera & signage. There would be a possibility that the Council could be permitted to purchase additional cameras at £500 each. (There would be annual licencing costs as well).

The Committee agreed to recommend to Full Council to accept the APNR camera (provided by Gloucestershire County Council) and to purchase additional cameras at a cost of £500 each.
