A recent Speed Watch exercise recorded 117 Registration Numbers, over 7 sessions, of vehicles exceeding the ACPO limits.

The Committee were pleased to note the efforts of the police over the summer which resulted in a speeding ticket being issued within the 20mph zone.

The Council will re-erect the Father Christmas initiative in December; in which a life size cut out of Santa is placed on New Street to remind drivers to slow down.

Difficulties for the Fire Service to get to a barn fire were reported. The Fire Service have agreed to drive around the villages when appropriate to highlight the issues with inconsiderate parking.
