- Electric Vehicle Charging points (EVC's) – working with a community group and Stroud District Council with a view to installing EVC's in Stamages Lane. Shortfall in funding needs to be resolved.

7. To consider issues that should be included in the Parish Plan Review

The Committee would like to implement some initiatives to assist with addressing Climate Change issues.

- Support scheme to install EVC's in Stamages Lane.
- Investigate grant and funding opportunities for further venues to install EVC's (like the Town Hall, Painswick Centre). Share information found with local businesses (Golf Club, Rocco Gardens, Richmond Retirement Village, Rugby Club etc).
- Bus – investigate ways to bus encourage use.
- Car use – investigate ways to reduce the reliance on car use, for example lift share schemes.
- Support local initiatives that reduce the need for car journeys, for example local market at the Painswick Centre.
- Encourage walking – improve footways and footpaths to ensure that are safe places to walk.
- Cycling – making it safer for cyclists and investigate any schemes to fund electric bikes.
- Investigate Air Quality monitoring – share findings so a greater appreciation of how small changes can make an impact.
