NOTICE OF PROPOSALS

**STROUD DISTRICT COUNCIL (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES)
(CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2010 (AS AMENDED) VARIATION ORDER 2019**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Stroud District Council intends to make the above Order ("the Variation Order") which will vary the Stroud District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2010 (As Amended) ("the 2010 Order") with the effect that:

1. The car park at Stratford Park, Stratford Road, Stroud shall be designated as an off-street parking place;
2. The parking charges at the car parks in Painswick and Stonehouse shall be abolished;
3. All off-street parking places except for Stratford Park shall have a maximum gross vehicle weight of 3,500kg;
4. Alterations are made to the boundaries of the off-street parking places at Church Street, Stroud and Newmarket Road and Old Market West, Nailsworth; and
5. Provision is made for payments by credit and debit card where appropriate machinery is installed, the use of electric vehicle charging points and to clarify the penalty charge regime.
